Although the main part of the meeting will be dedicated to Toxins and Signalling, Thursday afternoon will be opened to communications on recent results in other toxin fields such as: identification of new toxins, structure/function of toxins, toxins and environment, envenomation... Communications from young scientists (PhD, post-docs...) are strongly encouraged.

CALL FOR COMMUNICATION

You are invited to propose an oral communication or a poster in the central theme of the meeting, as well as in other toxinology fields. In that goal, you have to send an abstract of no more than one page to the SFET secretary (fgoudey@noos.fr) before **June 15th 2009**, except if you have previously submitted a manuscript for publication in the 2009 e-book (see below).

CALL FOR PUBLICATION

Since last year, and after seven books of the series « Rencontres en Toxinologie » edited by the SFET, the society has decided to publish e-books. The 2009 e-book will be available on line, free of charges, at the beginning of the meeting.

The manuscript corresponding to a selected abstract must be sent to the SFET secretary before **June 15th 2009**, to be examined by two referees.
